



GET THE SCOOP ON SATURDAY CHILD CARE & YOUTH PROGRAMS

Child & Youth Services provides child care and youth programming on Saturdays at no cost for active duty parents who must work to meet mission requirements and for National Guard and Reserve parents during Battle Training Assembly. In addition, child and youth programming is available for other parents needing the services at an hourly or daily rate. All users must first be registered with Child & Youth Services. Registration is free to eligible users through Army Family Covenant funding.

ACCESSING CARE: Register for Child & Youth Services at the Central Enrollment Office in Joe E Mann Community Center, Bldg 3392, Magruder Avenue, 751-4865.

Contact the appropriate program based on your child's age/grade and make reservations for care by Wednesday each week. Reservations accepted later in emergency situations. Please cancel reservations that are not needed.

For "free" care submit a memorandum from your chain of command verifying your Saturday mission related work hours (active duty) or scheduled Battle Training Assembly (Guard & Reserve).

COST: No cost for active duty parents during mission work hours
No cost for Guard and Reserve soldiers during Battle Training Assembly
No cost for families of deployed soldiers using their Deployment Respite Hours or for families using their Exceptional Family Member Program Respite Hours
\$3.50 per hour/\$25 per day for all others
